We had two teams partake in the 2019 Monterey Bay Regional Competition:

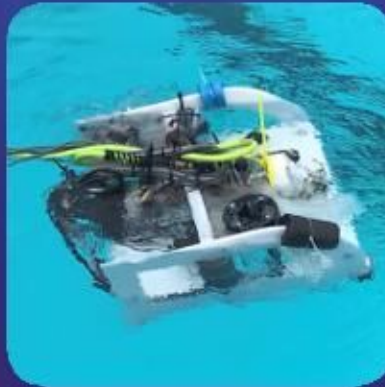
