














# Entourage Yearbooks - Digital Proof Living History New Helvetia Sutters Fort



During our Living History day at Sutter's Fort, we spent a full 24 hours reenacting what the pioneers and Californios experienced in the 1840s. Through firsthand interaction and hands-on experiences, students' history lesson of Old California come to life. Our journey back in time started early in the morning at the California State Railroad Museum in Old town Sacramento where students boarded a wagon train that brought them to New Helvita. Students experienced what a daily life in the 1840's might have been like. Students rotated through the different stations of bread making in an adobe oven, cooking our dinner over a fire in the historical kitchen, blacksmithing with "Biscuits" the Blacksmith, learning about trappers and many other activities. At night we shared a meal of frijoles, chicken cooked over fire in Dutch ovens. 




The Sonora site goes for the gold when they have a murder mystery party. This year's suspenseful event was titled

event.



















